



**Frank Phillips College  
Drug Test Consent and Policy Form**

If results of drug testing show a positive use of illegal drugs, steroids, or alcohol the athlete will have an opportunity to discuss the matter with the President and Head Coach of my sport. The athlete may present evidence of any rebuttal or mitigating circumstances that he/she feels is important. Following this discussion, a decision concerning my participation in athletics at Frank Phillips College will be made at that time by the Head Coach of my sport.

The decision may be one or more of the following:

1. A probationary period with the possibility of immediate loss of scholarship for a designated period of time.
2. Suspension from the team with immediate loss of scholarship for the remainder of the school year.
3. Removal from the institution.

Furthermore, if the results of said test show a positive use of illegal drugs, steroids, or alcohol that athlete or their specimen can be re-tested to assure that the athlete continues to show negative use of these illegal drugs. Additionally, the cost of any subsequent tests will possibly be that of the athlete.

Drug tests can be both random and under cause of suspicion. The athlete is free to refuse to consent to drug testing under this program. However, upon declining participation in the testing program, which is designed to protect the athlete's health and reputation, the athlete will not be eligible for a scholarship or to participate in any intercollegiate sport offered by Frank Phillips College. If the athlete refuses to test for drugs as provided in the athletic policy, after initially consenting, it would be considered that the athlete has made a decision not to participate and will forfeit his or her scholarship immediately.

Frank Phillips College, its Board of Trustees, its officers, employees and agents are hereby released from any legal responsibility or liability as a result of their compliance herewith.

**Consent**

I hereby consent to have samples of my urine collected and tested to determine if certain drugs are present. I understand that urinalysis testing is required by the Athletic Department of Frank Phillips College and is a part of the approved policies governing the institution. The results of said test will be kept confidential and can only be viewed by the President, Head Coach of my sport, Assistant Coach so designated by the Head Coach, and any administrator so designated by the college.
