GRADING POLICY

In order to continue in the nursing program, a grade average of 75 must be maintained in each Nursing course. A course grade lower than 75 will result in the student being dropped from the program. In order to take the final exam in each course the student must have a major exam grade of 74.45 (This does not include homework)

Nursing Grading Scale:

- A: 92-100
- B: 83-91
- C: 75-82
- D: 60-74
- F: Below 60

METHODS OF EVALUATION

At the end of course, following the administration of the final exam the grade will be obtained as follows:

- Assignments 15%
- Major exam grade 50%
- Final exam grade 20%
- HESI 15%

REMEDICATION (Note: There is an additional “Remediation Policy”)

Group and individual remediation will be offered to all students and will be required for students scoring less than 75 on weekly exams 1st semester. 2nd semester remediation will be offered at the student’s request by making an appointment with the instructor.

FINAL COURSE EXIT POLICIES

An end of course comprehensive exit exam (HESI PN Comprehensive Predictor) will be given. Students will be required to score a 900. If a score of 900 is not met, student must attend remediation and purchase the extra exams, if needed, until director deems student ready for the NCLEX.

NCLEX-PN REVIEW

NCLEX-PN review will be provided as part of the FPC nursing program and all students will be required to complete the review.

AFFIDAVIT OF GRADUATION (AOG)

The student’s AOG will be released after the student has successfully completed the course including the comprehensive exit exam, the NCLEX-Review, and all remediation the director deems necessary.
