

**BORGER COMMUNITY ACTIVITY CENTER (BCAC)
WINTER 2019 ADULT BASKETBALL LEAGUE RULES**

A. ORGANIZATIONAL INFORMATION

1. The league will utilize the playing rules of the National Collegiate Athletic Association (N.C.A.A.) Basketball Rules, except as amended by the Borger Community Activity Center By-Laws and policies. Anyone with questions as to policies, rules or regulations should contact the BCAC at (806) 457-4218.
2. Good sportsmanship will be required of all league participants. Teams that register for the basketball league accept as a condition of participation the following bylaws and rules and are subject to discipline as outlined herein.
3. **No personal checks will be accepted;** however we will accept company checks. No refunds are allowed after three days past the registration deadline. League scheduling will have begun by three days after the registration deadline.

B. NUMBER OF PLAYERS TO START AND FINISH

1. Teams may start and finish a game with four players.
2. 3 male players and 2 female players are required on the court. If a team only has 1 female present then they must play with only 4 players (3 males and 1 female) on the court. Teams who are short a player can pick-up a player from another team, but the same player cannot play with a team other than their own team more than once. In the playoffs, teams **MUST** have 2 females to avoid a forfeit.
3. Game time is forfeit time, **DON'T BE LATE!!!**

C. SCORING

1. Males will be awarded 1 point for a made free throw, 2 points for a made shot inside the three-point line, and 3 points for a made shot outside of the three-point line.
2. Females will be awarded an additional free throw per shooting opportunity (i.e. fouled while shooting, fouled in a bonus situation, or fouled in a double-bonus situation), 3 points for a made shot inside the three-point line, and 4 points for a made shot outside of the three-point line.

D. GAME CLOCK

The length of the game is forty minutes, divided into two halves of twenty minutes with a running clock. The clock will be a regulation clock during the final two minutes of each half.

E. FOULS

Each team will be in the bonus at seven team fouls and the double bonus at ten team fouls. Players will be removed with five fouls in any one game.

F. FREE THROWS

Players can leave their position on the block **ON THE RELEASE** of the shooter.

G. HOME TEAM

The Home Team is the team located on the left of each scheduled game.

H. JERSEYS

Players participating in BCAC's basketball leagues are required to wear shirts with numbers. The jerseys do not have to be official, but need to at least be t-shirts with the numbers of players on the back. **SAME COLOR SHIRTS PLEASE**

I. JEWELRY

Players will not be permitted to play with jewelry including but not limited to knotted bandanas, hats, rings, watches, necklaces, or earrings.

J. **OVERTIME**

Overtime period will be three minutes with a regulation clock for the final minute of the overtime period. Each team will be awarded one time out during overtime, if the game results in a tie after the overtime period has commenced, both teams will be awarded a tie on their record.

K. **MERCY RULE**

When a team is winning by fifteen points within two minutes remaining in the game, the clock will not stop.

L. **TIMEOUTS**

Each team is awarded two timeouts per half and one timeout per overtime. Timeouts do not carry over.

M. **TIEBREAKERS**

Any teams that are tied with the same record at the end of the season will have the tiebreaker determined by the following:

- 1) Head to Head
- 2) Point differential
- 3) Coin Flip
