May 2011 to Aug 2015

- Overseeing two wranglers
 - Planned lessons together, evaluated the camper's work and performance
 - Gave advice to improve instructions for campers
 - Oversaw evening meetings to discuss the day and provide necessary direction; what could have gone better, the greatest part of the day and what needed to be improved
- Managed the care of 20 horses including:
 - Identifying veterinarian care needs such as injury treatment, disease treatment and prevention that are unique to large populations of equines to ensure animal health and welfare at the facility
 - Determine proper feeds for the different types of horses ("old men" vs. easy keepers)
- Evaluated each horse's temperament and rider's ability in order to make horse assignments based on the rider's capability and expertise
- Taught that safety was the most important thing around horses

- Showed campers the proper way to groom and tack up horses, the proper way to mount, steer, stop and go, etc.
- Created games on horseback that taught the proper way to ride
- Conducted trail rides, breakfast rides as well as an overnight ride
- Ensured facility maintenance was performed; tying fence, mending broken bridle reins, oiling saddles and keeping the barn picked up and swept
