Payment Methods

- Automatic bank payment (ACH)

Cost to Participate

- No enrollment fee if paying tuition in full
- \$30 returned payment fee (after two, your account will be cancelled and you will need to contact Student Central or the Business Office)

Payment Plan Dates

Summer 1 2019

e-cashier available on April 1

- May 3 - 30% of total bill due
- Jun 3 - 65% of total bill due
- Jul 3 - 100% of total bill due

Summer 2 2019

e-cashier available on April 1

- Jun 10 - 30% of total bill due
- Jul 10 - 65% of total bill due
- Aug 10 - 100% of total bill due

Fall 2019

e-cashier available on April 1

- Jul 25 - 25% of total bill due
- Aug 26 - 50% of total bill due
- Sep 25 - 75% of total bill due
- Oct 25 - 100% of total bill due

Spring 2020

e-cashier available on November 1

- Dec 20 - 25% of total bill due
- Jan 20 - 50% of total bill due
- Feb 20 - 75% of total bill due
- Mar 20 - 100% of total bill due
