Exposure to COVID-19

Have you had close contact with a person who tested positive for COVID-19?

A close contact is someone who:

- Lives in the same house as a sick person with COVID-19.
- Cares for a sick person with COVID-19.
- Has been within 6 feet of a sick person with COVID-19 for 15 minutes or longer in a 24-hour period.
- Has been in direct contact with secretions from a sick person with COVID-19.

If you have had exposure:

- Contact Jason Price, if comfortable doing so, at jprice@fpctx.edu or 806-457-4287 to report your exposure.
 - Watch for cough or trouble breathing.
 - · Wear a mask for 10 days after exposure.
 - If you develop symptoms GO HOME and inform both Jason Price and Jody Nolen.

If you have not had exposure:

Continue to conduct daily health assessments and maintain good hygiene and prevention standards including <u>washing hands</u>, <u>wearing a face cover</u>, <u>maintaining 6 feet of physical distance</u>, <u>cleaning and disinfecting common spaces before and after use</u>.

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
