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IRS Data Retrieval:

The recommended way to verify income is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool that is part of FAFSA on the Web. If you have not already used the tool, complete the following:

- Go to www.FAFSA.gov,
- Log in to the student's FAFSA,
- From the top of the page, click "Enter Section" on Section 6, "Student Financials"
- Follow the instructions to determine if the student and/or parent is eligible to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to transfer IRS income tax information into the student's FAFSA.
- Make sure you also submit the FAFSA for correction after determining/transferring the tax information from the IRS.

Tax Transcript & Letter of Non-filing Request from IRS:

If you or spouse (if applicable) is unable to use the Data Retrieval Tool, use the instructions below to request your IRS tax return transcript. If you or your spouse (if applicable) did not file a tax return and are required to submit a letter of non-filing follow the instructions below.
