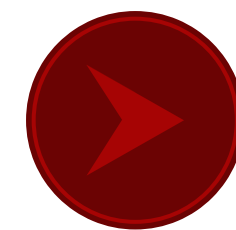


Welcome to TR **i**O!

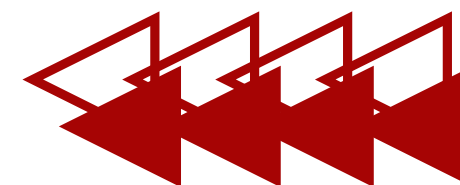


TR*i*O is a federally-funded student support program designed to help students succeed in college.

Our program is dedicated to helping you reach your educational goals, whatever they may be.



How TRiO helps:

Academic Tutoring

If you're having difficulty with a particular class, our tutors can work with you individually to better understand a specific concept or to complete assignments.



Financial Support

We can connect you with community resources who can help with the costs of going to college. We offer yearly scholarship opportunities, as well.



A Place to Study or Relax

Our lab has computers, textbooks, and is a great place for getting the help you need. We provide printing services, gaming, art supplies, and a comfortable spot to hang out.



Who is eligible for TRiO?



First - Generation Students

If neither of your parents had earned a 4-year degree by the time YOU turned 18, you are considered a first generation college student.



Disability

If you have any documented disability or impairment, such as a physical disability, learning disability, or emotional or mental condition that might require additional support, you qualify for TRiO.



Limited Income

If you qualify under federal financial guidelines, similar to those required to receive a Pell Grant, you are considered limited income.

TRiO members get to visit university campuses in our area to prepare for transfer. We also travel the Panhandle to sample the local art and culture offerings. 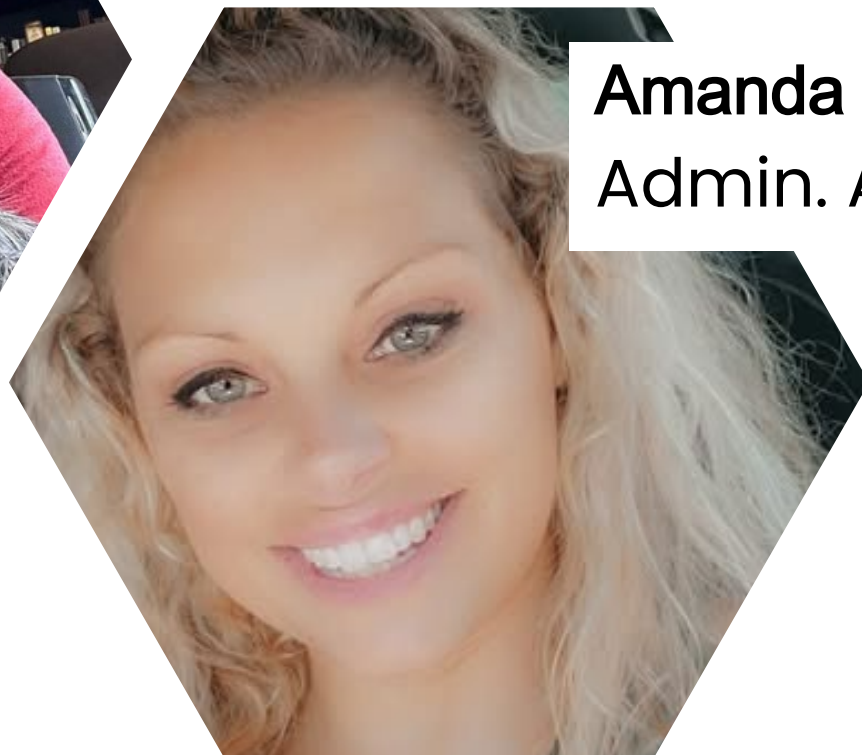
